This skill-based, two-day training is for people wanting to learn how narrative therapy ideas are put into practice in therapeutic settings. We explore externalizing practices and skills deconstructing and re-authoring therapy. Clinical examples and experiential exercises help support participants' learning. Participants can expect to learn how narrative practitioners work to help people separate their lives from problems and construct preferred stories that help them take new steps that fit with their hopes and values.

To enroll in this course, participants need to have completed NTI's "What Is Narrative Therapy?" workshop or an equivalent introductory training about the Narrative Worldview. If you are unsure if you are eligible for this training, please email NTI. After completing this course, you can further your skill development through NTI's Narrative Supervision Program or Narrative Certificate Program, which begin each fall.
